# Getting to the office

## 01 By train

Milton Keynes Central Station is a short walk from our office. Exit the station and follow signs towards Midsummer Boulevard. The Pinnacle is around a 10 minute walk.

## 02 By car – M1

- Exit the M1 at Junction 14, following signs for Central Milton Keynes.
  - From the roundabout, join the A509 towards Central Milton Keynes.
  - Continue onto V4 Watling Street (north-south route).
  - Turn onto H2 Midsummer Boulevard and continue towards the city centre.

## 03 By car – A5

- Follow signs for Central Milton Keynes and Midsummer Boulevard.
- The Pinnacle is centrally located on Midsummer Boulevard.

# Arriving at The Pinnacle

The Pinnacle is on Midsummer Boulevard, opposite the Olive Tree restaurant. You'll see "The Pinnacle" displayed on the building from street level.





# Street access and pay & display parking

If you're walking to the office or using the on street pay and display parking on Midsummer Boulevard, please use the upper entrance to the building.

We have a limited number of on-site parking spaces. If you require underground parking or a disabled parking bay, please let us know in advance so we can assist.

If you are using the underground car park, please follow the arrival and access steps on the next page.

## **Accessibility**

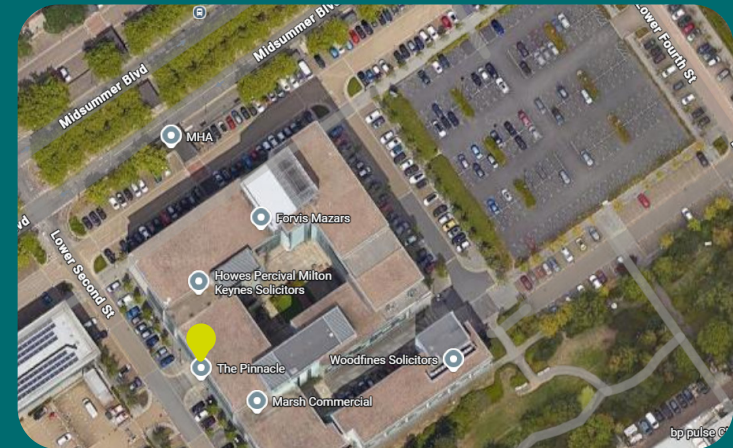
If you have any accessibility requirements, including the need for a disabled parking bay, please contact us ahead of your visit and we'll be happy to help.

# Parking in the underground car park



## 01 Underground car park access

The entrance to the underground car park is on the lower right-hand side of the building, off Lower Second Street.



## 02 On arrival in the car park

A member of the building security team will be there to help and they will direct you to your parking space.

Howes Percival spaces are located:

- On the right-hand side after driving past the ramp
- Towards the back of the car park
- Our spaces are numbered 68-72

# Getting to Reception

From the parking area, walk across the car park to the Core 1 Reception & Lifts (follow signposts below). Core 1 is on the opposite side of the car park to our parking spaces.



At the secure door:

- Press the buzzer
- Let security know you have a meeting with Howes Percival. They'll grant access through the door.

Take the lift to Level 3. On exiting the lift, you will see the Howes Percival reception door. Please make your way through the door (it is open) and a member of our team will be there to welcome you.
